

Scott McTominay & Bank of Scotland limited-edition banknote prize draw terms and conditions – May 2025

Prize Draw Overview

Bank of Scotland is running a prize draw where participants have the opportunity to win one of 25 limited-edition Scott McTominay commemorative banknotes (from a total production of 100).

Who Is Running the Prize Draw?

This prize draw is administered by GiveWheel and Leith Creative Agency Ltd, acting on behalf of the Promoter, and is also subject to the terms and conditions available at www.givewheel.com/terms.

Who is the Promoter?

How to Enter

- Enter via: www.gvwhl.com/McTom4 and complete the entry process/form.
- It's **£10 to enter**. This payment will be processed by GiveWheel and donated to the charity Crisis UK. GiveWheel are administering this prize draw on behalf of the Promoter and your entire £10 will go to Crisis UK. Multiple entries are permitted. 1 x £10 donation = one entry to this prize draw.
- Alternatively, enter through the free entry route (see below).
- No purchase is necessary to enter this prize draw.

Free Entry Route

Free entry is available by sending your name, address, telephone number, and email address in a correctly addressed and stamped envelope to: **FAO: Scott McTominay Campaign, The Leith Agency, 86/2 Commercial Quay, Edinburgh, EH6 6LX**. Entries must be received by **11:00am on 26 June 2026** to be valid. Multiple entries are permitted via the free entry route. 1 x valid postal entry in an individual stamped envelope = 1 entry to this prize draw. You cannot send multiple entries in the same envelope.

Each valid postal entry will receive one entry into the prize draw and will be processed in the same way as paid entries, with no disadvantage.

Prize Draw Dates

The prize draw opens at **9.00am on 22 May 2026** and closes at **11:00am on 26 June 2026**.

Eligibility

Open to UK residents aged 18 years or over only.

Who should not take part in the prize draw?

This prize draw is not aimed at children or vulnerable individuals. You are encouraged to enter responsibly and only if you can afford to do so. This prize draw is not intended to encourage financial hardship, debt, or excessive participation.

You cannot take part if you:

Why are they limited-edition notes?

How will winners be selected?

Paid entries online will be processed by GiveWheel. Postal entries will be sent to and processed by Leith Creative Agency Ltd. GiveWheel and Leith Creative Agency Ltd will collaborate to combine all valid entries into a single master list and conduct the winner selection process electronically.

Leith Creative Agency Ltd will be responsible for selecting the winners, who will be drawn at random using a computer process that produces verifiably random results.

Leith Creative Agency Ltd will contact winners directly via email from bankofscotland@leith.co.uk.

The Promoter reserves the right (in its sole discretion) to disqualify and/or refuse to award the prize(s) to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions (including eligibility requirements to enter). If such event arises after the winner is drawn, the Promoter reserves the right to (but is not obliged to) redraw that prize and randomly select an alternative winner from the list of valid entries.

Prize Delivery

The winners will be notified by email no later than 14 days after the draw has taken place. The address you will receive the email from is bankofscotland@leith.co.uk

Is there any social media connection?

Data Responsibility

For postal entries **you will provide your personal data directly to Leith Creative Agency Ltd**. Leith Creative Agency Ltd will combine entries (from online and postal entries), and will oversee the winner selection process, and arranging prize fulfilment of all prizes.

GiveWheel will share relevant entry details with Leith for these purposes. GiveWheel and Leith Creative Agency act as independent data controllers.
